

WINNICOTT'S PARADIGM ILLUSTRATED BY CLINICAL CASES

After showing that the essential aspect Winnicott's contribution to psychoanalysis consists in the modification of this discipline as a whole through a paradigm change, the present paper goes on to present one of the most significant novelties of Winnicott's revolutionary psychopathology: the regression to dependence, together with the clinical procedure devised for its treatment: the management. Both concepts will be illustrated by clinical cases. To that effect special attention will be given to Margaret Little's personal record of her analysis with Winnicott published in her book *Psychotic Anxieties and Containment* (1990).
